STUDY VSERSE SECTION - Jonah 1:17, HCSB - <sup>17</sup> [v. 17 is actually the first verse of the chapter in the Hebrew Bible] Now the LORD, הוהי the highest name for Holy God] had appointed (pie-el) means to designate; specify; appoint, or ordain] a huge fish (dag-"fish" lit. of the sea) הָגרוֹל, (ga-dol) "really big" to swallow [indicating an involuntary action or hostile act] Jonah, and Jonah was in the fish three days and three nights.

**Jonah 1:17, NLT** -<sup>17</sup> Now <u>the LORD had arranged</u> for a great fish to swallow Jonah. And Jonah was inside the fish for three days and three nights.
