We need not fear if we, too...

1. Hear the _____ of Christ.

Revelation 1:10–11, NIV84 - ¹⁰ On the <u>Lord's Day</u> [not "the day of the Lord" but "the Lord's day"—Sunday] *I was in the Spirit* ["His experience transcended the bounds of normal human apprehension." - J. MacArthur], and *I heard* [ἀκούω lit., "to hear" or "to be called" (acoustic)] behind me a loud voice like a trumpet, ¹¹ which said: "Write on a scroll what you see and send it to the seven churches: to Ephesus, Smyrna, Pergamum, Thyatira, Sardis, Philadelphia and Laodicea."

A. His Presence with the Churches (Jesus is here!)

Revelation 1:12–13, NLT - ¹² When I turned to see who was speaking to me, I saw seven gold <u>lampstands</u> [these are the seven churches]. ¹³ And standing in the middle of the lampstands was someone like <u>the Son of Man</u> [a reference to "the coming Messiah" in Dan. 7:13; Jesus calls Himself the "Son of Man" 81 times in the Gospels; it's the same phrase John used of Jesus on the cross.]

B. His Robe of Authority

Revelation 1:13, NIV84 - ¹³ ...dressed in a <u>robe</u> [ποδήρης, the robe of a priest worn in the temple] reaching down to his feet and with a <u>golden sash around his chest</u> [worn only by the High Priest.]

C. His Appearance of Wisdom

Revelation 1:14, NIV84 - ¹⁴ His head and hair were white like wool, as white as snow, and his eyes were like blazing fire.

D. His Posture of Power

Revelation 1:15, NIV84 - ¹⁵ His <u>feet were like bronze</u> glowing in a furnace, and his voice was like the sound of rushing waters.

E. His Life-Force for the Churches

Revelation 1:16, NIV84 - ¹⁶ In <u>his right hand</u> he held <u>seven stars</u> [these represent the seven "messengers" (pastors/angels)], and <u>out of his mouth</u> <u>came a sharp double-edged sword</u>. His face was like the sun shining in all its brilliance.

3. Experience the ______ of Christ.

Revelation 1:17, NIV84 - ¹⁷ When I saw him, I fell at his feet as though dead. <u>Then he placed his right hand on me and said: "Do</u> not be afraid. I am the First and the Last.

4. Yield to the _____ of Christ.

Revelation 1:9, NIV84 - ⁹ *I, John, your brother and companion in the* suffering and kingdom and patient endurance that are ours in Jesus, was on the island of Patmos because of the word of God and the testimony of Jesus.
