A Brief Word to Parents

Proverbs 22:6, NASB95 - ⁶ Train up a child in the way he should go, Even when he is old he will not depart from it.

Proverbs 22:6, TCV - "Create within your child a hunger and thirst for the things of God and when he/she is older he/she will continue to have a heart for God."



STUDE VERSE SECTION - Exodus 20:12, NASB95 - 12 "Honor [Heb. "absolute imperfect verb" denoting 'a habitual action still in progress' lit., esteem and/or value (used 150+in OT)] your father and your mother, that your days may be <u>prolonged</u> [Under Levitical law, to curse one's parents was a capital offense (Lev. 20:9). Honoring them, on the other hand, brought great blessing (Ex. 20:12)] in the land which the LORD [Heb. ההה "Yahweh" The real Creator God—the highest name for God given to Moses for the Israelites] *your God gives you*.

Exodus 20:12, NASB95 - ¹² "Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be prolonged in the land which the LORD your God gives you.

Exodus 20:12, NLT - ¹² "Honor your father and mother. Then you will live a long, full life in the land the LORD your God is giving you.
