STUDY SECTION

STUDY VERSE SECTION - 1 Peter 5:8–9, NASB95 - ⁸ Be of <u>sober</u> [a metaphor, meaning to be focused or to prioritize] <u>spirit</u>, <u>be on the alert</u> [an imperative command that means "be watchful" or "stay awake"]. Your <u>adversary</u> [lit., enemy or opponent], <u>the devil</u> [Gk: diabolos, Eng. diabolical, meaning "a malicious enemy who slanders, lies, diverts and attacks"], <u>prowls around like a roaring lion</u>, seeking someone to <u>devour</u> [lit., to gulp down; this verse could be a veiled allusion to the horrors of the Nerionian persecution in the Roman Coliseum, in which lions mauled and devoured Christians—Satan seeks to do the same thing]. ⁹ But <u>resist</u> [lit., discern, oppose, stand against] <u>him</u>, [stand] <u>firm</u> [Gk: steréos, Eng. stereo, meaning be solid on both ends] in your <u>faith</u> [lit., biblical revelation; it describes a "once-and-for-all" faith], <u>knowing that the same experiences</u> of <u>suffering are being accomplished by your brethren who are in the world</u> [Peter adds another source of strength; the confidence that comes from knowing that we do not fight alone].

Your Adversary, SATAN, is....

a tempter (Matt. 4:1ff); a deceiver (1 John 5:19); a liar (John 8:44), a polluter (Matt. 13:38), a stealer (Luke 8:14), a perverter (Matt. 4:6), a destroyer (Rev. 20:2), a murderer (John 8:44), an accuser (Rev. 12:10), a schemer (2 Cor 2:11) and he is the prince of this world (Eph. 6:12), the power in the air (Eph. 2:2) and ruler of darkness (Eph. 6:12).

Your Great Adversary

1. Comes to Destroy.

1 Peter 5:8, TLB -⁸ Be careful—watch out for attacks from Satan, <u>your great enemy</u>. He prowls around like a hungry, roaring lion, <u>looking for some victim to tear apart</u>.

Revelation 9:11, TLB - ¹¹ Their king is the Prince of the bottomless pit whose name in Hebrew is <u>Abaddon</u> [lit., one who destroys (v)], and in Greek, <u>Apollyon</u> [lit., Destroyer (n)] and in English, <u>the Destroyer</u> [(v) and (n)].

2. Comes to Deceive.

2 Corinthians 11:13–15, NIV84 - ¹³ For such men are <u>false</u> apostles, <u>deceitful</u> workmen, <u>masquerading as apostles of Christ</u>. ¹⁴ And no wonder, for <u>Satan himself masquerades as an angel of light</u>. ¹⁵ It is not surprising, then, if his servants masquerade as servants of righteousness. Their end will be what their actions deserve.

John 8:44, NASB95 - ⁴⁴ "He (Satan) was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth <u>because there is no truth in him</u>. Whenever he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own nature, for <u>he</u> is a liar and the father of lies.

Revelation 12:9, NLT - ⁹ This great dragon—the ancient serpent called the devil, or Satan, the one deceiving the whole world—was thrown down to the earth with all his angels....

3. Comes to Divert.

Ephesians 6:12, NASB95 - ¹² For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the <u>rulers</u>, against the <u>powers</u>, against the world forces of this darkness, against the spiritual forces of wickedness...

James 4:7, NLT - ⁷ So <u>humble yourselves before God</u>. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

Before we can stand against Satan, we must bow before God.

1 Peter 5:9-10, JBP - Be self-controlled and vigilant always, for your enemy the devil is always about, prowling like a lion roaring for its prey; always seeking to divert us from God. Resist Satan, standing firm in your faith, remembering the strain is the same for all your fellow-Christians in other parts of the world.

Revere God, Resist Satan and Remember the Saints
