BREVIEW FROM LAST WEEK'S MESSAGE:

- We need to let Christ put His right hand on us and we need to hear His words, "Do not be afraid!"
- Jesus Christ is coming again to rescue those who believe in Him.

Christ said Five Things to John

1. "Do not be !"

Revelation 1:17, NIV84 - ¹⁷ When I saw him, I fell at his feet as though dead. Then he placed his right hand on me and said: "Do not be afraid"

Revelation 1:17. NLT - ¹⁷ When I saw him. I fell at his feet as if I were dead. But he laid his right hand on me and said, "Don't be afraid! [GK: A PRESENT, ACTIVE, IMPERATIVE with a NEGATIVE PARTICLE, meaning to stop an act that is already in process, lit., "you're fearing-stop it!"]

Matthew 10:30–31, NLT - ³⁰ And the very hairs on your head are all numbered.³¹ So don't be afraid; you are more valuable to God than a whole flock of sparrows.

2. "I am the first and the _____

Revelation 1:17, NCV - ¹⁷ When I saw him, I fell down at his feet like a dead man. He put his right hand on me and said, "Do not be afraid. I am the First and the Last.

Revelation 22:13, NIV84 - ¹³ I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End.

3. "I am the One."

Revelation 1:18a, NIV84 - ¹⁸ I am the Living One; I was dead, and behold I am alive for ever and ever!

- The resurrection was God's stamp of approval (Acts 2.24, Eph 1.20)
- The resurrection was God's demonstration of His Spirit's power (Rom. 8.11)
- The resurrection was God's demonstration of Jesus' power (John 10:17-18)

4. "I hold the ."

Revelation 1:18b, NIV84 - ¹⁸ ... And I hold the keys of death and Hades.

Revelation 1:18b, MSG -¹⁸ ... See these keys in my hand? They open and lock Death's doors, they open and lock Hell's gates.

5. I know things.

Revelation 1:19–20, NIV84 - ¹⁹ "Write, therefore, what you have seen, what is now and what will take place later.²⁰ The mystery of the seven stars that you saw in my right hand and of the seven golden lampstands is this: The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches, and the seven lampstands are the seven churches.

- Past The things you have seen (Rev. 1—who Christ is)
- Present The things that are (Rev 2-3—the seven churches)
- future The things that will be (Rev. 4-22—future events)

Practical Insights from Revelation 1

- A. The better our understanding of who Christ really is, the quicker we'll respond in complete surrender and obedience.
- B. The greater our willingness to submit to Christ, the deeper will be the truths He reveals to us.
