### STUDY SECTION

## A GODLY HEART IS BETTER THAN A GODLESS THRONE

### 1. The Prostration before Daniel

Daniel 2:46, NASB95 - 46 Then King Nebuchadnezzar fell on his face
[lit., 'came to his level' and 'came face to face'; KJV "fell prostrate"] and did homage [Heb.
סגד (sa-GEED) means to come 'honor' or 'profusely thank' (and not 'worship,' as we think of worship); remember that as a polytheist (who worshipped many gods), the king could easily add one more deity to all the gods he worshipped)] to Daniel, and gave orders to present to him an offering and fragrant incense [The king kept his promise about the reward].

### 2. The Praise for Daniel's God

**Daniel 2:47, NASB95** - <sup>47</sup> The king answered Daniel and said, "<u>Surely your God is a God of gods and a Lord of kings and a revealer of mysteries</u>, since you have been able to reveal this mystery."

### 3. The Promotion of Daniel

**Daniel 2:48, NASB95** - <sup>48</sup> Then the <u>king promoted Daniel</u> and gave him many great gifts, and he made him ruler over the whole province of Babylon and chief prefect over all the wise men of Babylon.

### 4. The Presents for Daniel

**Daniel 2:48, NASB95** - <sup>48</sup> Then the king promoted Daniel <u>and gave</u> <u>him many great gifts</u>, and he made him ruler over the whole province of Babylon and chief prefect over all the wise men of Babylon.

### 5. The Petition of Daniel

**Daniel 2:49, NASB95** - <sup>49</sup> And <u>Daniel made request of the king</u>, and he appointed Shadrach, Meshach and Abed-nego over the administration of the province of Babylon, while Daniel was at the king's court.
