STUDY SECTION

THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO THIS WORLD

As represented by the statue of King Nebuchadnezzar

1. Glorify _

Daniel 3:1–3, NASB95 - ¹ Nebuchadnezzar the king made an image of gold, the height of which was <u>sixty cubits</u> [over 90 feet tall] and its width six cubits [approximately 9 feet]; he set it up on the plain of <u>Dura</u> [lit., a walled-in place, of which there are many in ancient Babylon (present day Iraq)] in the province of Babylon. ² Then Nebuchadnezzar the king sent word to assemble the [IMPORTANT: Every level of authority in that government was represented] <u>satraps</u> [generals—highest officers of the military], the <u>prefects</u> [assistants to the satraps—military commander] and the <u>governors</u> [who ruled over smaller districts], the <u>counselors</u> [experts advisors], the <u>treasurers</u> [served as treasurers do today], the <u>judges</u> [experts in the judging the law],

the <u>magistrates</u> [from which we get our concept of a sheriff—assigned to keep the law] and all the <u>rulers</u> [rf., law enforcers or deputies of that day] of the provinces to come to the dedication of the image that Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up. ³ Then...<u>all the rulers of the provinces were assembled for the</u> <u>dedication of the image that Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up;</u> and they stood before the image that Nebuchadnezzar had set up.

Daniel 2:31–32, NASB95 -³¹ "You, O king, were looking [in your dream] and behold, there was a single great statue; that statue, which was large and of extraordinary splendor, was standing in front of you, and its appearance was awesome. ³² "The head of that statue was made of fine gold...³⁸ You [King Nebuchadnezzar] are the head of gold.

2. Deify

Daniel 3:4,7 NASB95 - ⁴ Then the <u>herald</u> [we get our word "preacher" from this phrase—one who represents the king in all matters—especially 'eternal' ones] loudly proclaimed: "To you the command is given, O peoples, nations and men of every language...⁷ Therefore at that time...all the people...fell down and worshiped the <u>golden image</u> [the Greek copy of the OT, the LXX translates it "the statue of a man"] that Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up.

3. Falsify ______.

Daniel 3:5–6, NASB95 - ⁵ that at the moment you <u>hear the sound of</u> the horn, flute, lyre, trigon, psaltery, bagpipe and all kinds of music, you are to fall down and worship the golden image that Nebuchadnezzar the king has set up. ⁶ "<u>But whoever does not fall</u> down and worship shall immediately be cast into the midst of a furnace of blazing fire."
