

Four Reasons I'm Pro Life

1. Theological (Bible)

A. God Created Life.

Genesis 2:7, NASB95 -⁷ *Then the LORD God formed man of dust from the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living being.*

Ruth 4:13, NASB95 -¹³ *So Boaz took Ruth, and she became his wife, and he went in to her. And the LORD enabled her to conceive, and she gave birth to a son.*

Isaiah 44:24, NASB95 -²⁴ *Thus says the LORD, your Redeemer, and the one who formed you from the womb, "I, the LORD, am the maker of all things, Stretching out the heavens by Myself And spreading out the earth all alone...."*

B. God controls life (and death).

1 Samuel 2:6, NLT -⁶ *The LORD gives both death and life; he brings some down to the grave but raises others up.*

Job 1:21, ESV -²¹ *And he said, "Naked I came from my mother's womb, and naked shall I return. The LORD gave, and the LORD has taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD."*

Exodus 20:13, ESV -¹³ *"You shall not murder."*

C. God cares about life.

Jeremiah 1:5, NIV -⁵ *"Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I set you apart; I appointed you as a prophet to the nations."*

Matthew 10:29–31, NASB95 -²⁹ *"Are not two sparrows sold for a cent? And yet not one of them will fall to the ground apart from your Father. ³⁰ "But the very hairs of your head are all numbered. ³¹ "So do not fear; you are more valuable than many sparrows."*

Isaiah 44:2, GN - *"I am your creator. I cherished you even before you were born."*

2. Ecclesiological (Church)

Ephesians 5:25, NASB95 -²⁵ *Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her....*

1 Thessalonians 1:4, NLT -⁴ *We know, dear brothers and sisters, that God loves you and has chosen you to be his own people.*

3. Scientific (Facts)

No educated biologist would dispute the claim that a fetus is alive. In biology, there are **seven criteria for determining whether something is a living organism**¹, and a fetus meets all of those criteria:

Like all living organisms, **a fetus maintains an internal equilibrium** by producing various chemicals and bodily effects (homeostasis).

Like all living organisms, **a fetus is organized**, meaning it is composed of at least one cell.

Like all living organisms, **a fetus has a metabolism** – it can transform chemicals into cellular components and break down complex substances for energy.

Like all living organisms, **a fetus can adapt to changes in its environment**.

Like all living organisms, **a fetus develops reproductive features**.

Like all living organisms, **a fetus responds to stimuli**.

Like all living organisms, **a fetus grows**.

Therefore, since the fetus possesses a human genome, it cannot be anything other than human...." To accept the fact that after fertilization has taken place a new human has come into being is no longer a matter of taste or opinion ... it is just plain evidence of reality."³

"At conception, 23 pairs of chromosomes are present and active. By the fourth week of life, a baby's brain, spinal cord, and heart begin to develop. At six weeks, facial features begin to form, the skeleton is complete, and brain wave patterns can be recorded. At eight weeks, all organs are functioning and all systems are intact. At twenty weeks, the unborn child has hair and functioning vocal cords, sucks her thumb, kicks, and grasps with her hands. She feels pain even more intensely than adults."⁴

4. Political (Ethics)

(C) A white man rapes a 13-year-old black girl and she becomes pregnant? _____.


(D) A very young teenager is pregnant, but her fiancée is not the father of the baby? _____.

Four Positions You Can Take on Abortion

Since 1973, four positions have been taken in the abortion debate:

2. Therapeutic abortions can be performed to save the mother's life.
3. Extreme case abortions can be permitted in cases of rape, incest, or severe deformation of the fetus.
4. Abortion should be available to any woman who chooses it. This is the typical "pro-choice" position.
