#### This Unnamed Woman's Deed Reveals Certain Qualities All Should Emulate:

### 1. An Extravagant Love for Christ.

**Mark 14:3–5, HCSB** -<sup>3</sup> While He was in Bethany at the house of Simon who had a serious skin disease, as He was reclining at the table, a woman came with an alabaster jar of pure and expensive fragrant oil of nard. <u>She broke the jar and poured it on His head</u>. <sup>4</sup> But some were expressing indignation to one another: "Why has this fragrant oil been wasted? <sup>5</sup> For this oil might have been sold for more than 300 denarii and given to the poor." And they began to scold her.

**Mark 14:5, TLB** -<sup>4</sup> Some of those at the table were indignant among themselves about this "waste," as they called it. "Why, she could have sold that perfume for a fortune and given the money to the poor!" they snarled.

## 2. An Exemplary Service unto Christ.

Mark 14:6, HCSB -<sup>6</sup> Then Jesus said, "Leave her alone. Why are you bothering her? <u>She has done a noble thing for Me</u>."

**Mark 14:6, NCV** -<sup>6</sup> Jesus said, "Leave her alone. Why are you troubling her? <u>She did an excellent thing for me</u>."

## 3. An Expectant Faith in Christ.

**Mark 14:7–8, HCSB** -<sup>7</sup> You always have the poor with you, and you can do what is good for them whenever you want, but you do not always have Me. <sup>8</sup> She has done what she could; she has anointed My body in advance for burial.

#### The Context for This Story:

- A. Maybe, this lady was with Jesus and the disciples when they traveled from Caesarea Philippi to Jerusalem (Mark 15:40-41).
- B. Jesus used two examples:
  - The picture of a humble child (Mark 9:35-37).
  - The picture of a humble servant (Mark 10:43-35).

# C. There are three previous "reactions" to His predictions about His death in Jerusalem.

- Mark 8:31-34 Peter didn't get it.
- Mark 9:30-32 The disciples didn't get it.
- Mark 10:32-34 James and John didn't get it.
- D. The unnamed woman got it!

Mark 14:8–9, HCSB -<sup>8</sup> She has done what she could; <u>she has anointed</u> My body in advance for burial. <sup>9</sup> I assure you: Wherever the gospel is proclaimed in the whole world, <u>what this woman has done will also</u> be told in memory of her."
