### STUDY VERSE SECTION - Proverbs 14:34–35, HCSB -<sup>34</sup> *Righteousness*

[Translates the Heb. צְדָקָה (sta-da-ka) and means *virtue, justness, blameless behavior*, “Adherence to what is required according to a preset standard.” (K&D)] *exalts* [Lit., “To raise in rank, character or status” (TWOT)] *a nation, but sin* [Lit., “To ignore something required by Holy God” (LTW)] *is a disgrace* [Heb. חִקְוֹן (HIGH-said) means “disgrace, shame, abuse, or a reproach” (TWOT)] *to any people.*<sup>35</sup>  
*A king favors a wise servant, but his anger falls on a disgraceful one.*

### Three Actions We Can Take Regarding Righteousness

#### 1. You can get serious about personal righteousness.

**Ezekiel 22:30–31, NIV84** -<sup>30</sup> *“I looked for a man among them who would build up the wall and stand before me in the gap on behalf of the land so I would not have to destroy it, but I found none. <sup>31</sup> So I will pour out my wrath on them and consume them with my fiery anger, bringing down on their own heads all they have done, declares the Sovereign LORD.”*
