STUDY SECTION

Key Word #1 - Building

1. It's Foundation is

<u>STUDY VERSE SECTION - 1 Peter 2:4, NASB95</u> - ⁴ And coming to <u>Him</u> [lit, as we draw near to Jesus, cf., v. 3] as to a <u>living stone</u> [lit, life-giving—it had cultural significance as the "stone that gave life" to the structure (Kittel's TDNT)] which has been rejected by men, but is <u>choice</u> [From the Gk: eklektos, meaning set apart] and <u>precious</u> [lit., of highest value] in the sight of God...

1 Peter 2:4, TLB -⁴ Come to Christ, <u>who is the living Foundation of</u> <u>Rock upon which God builds</u>; though men have spurned him, he is very precious to God who has chosen him above all others.

2. It's Superstructure are the

STUDY VERSE SECTION - 1 Peter 2:5, NASB95 - ⁵ you also, as living stones [this Gk. word denotes a rock, hewn in a specific shape for a specific purpose], are being built up as a spiritual house [When Solomon consecrated the first temple, he asked God to dwell with His people, Israel. God now dwells within His people, the Church.] for a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.

1 Peter 2:5, NLT -⁵ And <u>you are living stones that God is building</u> <u>into his spiritual temple</u>. What's more, you are his holy priests. Through the mediation of Jesus Christ, you offer spiritual sacrifices that please God.

3. It's Sacrifices are Pleasing to

STUDY VERSE SECTION - 1 Peter 2:5, NASB95 - ⁵ you also, as living stones, are being built up as a spiritual house for a <u>holy priesthood</u>, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.

STUDY VERSE SECTION - 1 Peter 2:6–8, NASB95 -⁶ For this is contained in Scripture: "BEHOLD, I LAY IN ZION A CHOICE STONE, A PRECIOUS <u>CORNER stone</u>, AND HE WHO BELIEVES IN HIM WILL NOT BE [a double negative in Gk., lit., will not ever never be] DISAPPOINTED [lit., become a future disappointment (perf. nominative)]."⁷ <u>This precious value, then, is for you who</u> <u>believe</u>; but for those who disbelieve, "THE STONE WHICH THE BUILDERS <u>REJECTED</u>, THIS BECAME THE VERY <u>CORNER</u> stone," ⁸ and, "A <u>STONE OF STUMBLING</u> AND A <u>ROCK OF OFFENSE</u>"; for <u>they</u> [the unbelievers] stumble because they are <u>disobedient to the word</u>, and to this doom they were also appointed [this is not f., "election" (or 'double predestination') but is simply pointing out what God says will happen to those who reject His word].

LIFE APPLICATION SECTION

Three Questions for this "Building"

- **1. Who is Jesus?** Answer: (1) To God, He is the chosen stone; (2) To the world, He is the stumbling stone; and (3) to believers, He is the foundation stone.
- **2. Who are believers?** Answers: We are people who draw near to God (v. 4); We are the spiritual house and a holy priesthood [duty and privilege] (v. 5); We are those who will never be put to shame (v. 6); We are precious to Christ (v. 7).
- 3. What if the "new temple" in Revelation 22 is not really a building per se?
