₱ Review From Last Week's Message:

- The church at Thyatira was "The Corrupt Church."
- They were accepting of corrupt teaching (from Jezebel).
- The enemies of the church continue to be idolatry and immorality.
- We must never become corrupt in our doctrines and teachings.
- We must "speak the truth in love".
- Jesus Christ is coming again to rescue those who believe in Him.



1. CHURCH—The Church at Sardis.

Revelation 3:1, NIV84 - ¹ "To the angel of the church in <u>Sardis</u> [which means *remnant*—a fitting description for this church], *write*:

2. CONFIRMATION—Christ—as the Life-Giver—holds the seven-fold Spirit and seven stars.

Revelation 3:1a (TLB) - "This message is sent to you by the one who has the sevenfold Spirit of God and the seven stars...

Isaiah 11:2 (NIV) - ² The <u>Spirit of the Lord</u> will rest on him— the Spirit of <u>wisdom</u> and of <u>understanding</u>, the Spirit of <u>counsel</u> and of power, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord...

3. COMMENDATION—Some have not soiled their garments.

Revelation 3:4, NIV84 - ⁴ Yet you have <u>a few people in Sardis</u> who have not soiled their clothes. They will walk with me, dressed in white, for they are worthy.

4. COMPLAINT—They are dead and their deeds are not right.

Revelation 3:1 (NLT) - ¹ This is the message from the one who has the sevenfold Spirit of God and the seven stars: "I know all the things you do, and that you have a <u>reputation</u> [Gk: ὄνομα, onoma, means "name" and derives into "denomination", for being alive—but you are <u>dead</u> [GK: νεκρός, nekros, meaning death or corpse.]

5. COMMAND—"Turn back to God."

Revelation 3:2–3, NIV84 - ² <u>Wake up! Strengthen what remains</u> and is about to die, for I have not found your deeds complete in the sight of my God. ³ <u>Remember</u>, therefore, what you have received and heard; <u>obey</u> it, and <u>repent</u>. But if you do not wake up, I will come like a thief, and you will not know at what time I will come to you.

- ☐ Wake up!
- □ Strengthen what remains!
- ☐ Hold fast to God's Word!

"Think of the gift you once had in your hands, the Message you heard with your ears—grasp it again." - v 3a, MSG

☐ Turn back to God!

6. COMFORT—Eternal security.

Revelation 3:4–6, NIV84 - ⁴ Yet you have a few people in Sardis who have not soiled their clothes. <u>They will walk with me, dressed in white, for they are [will be declared (nominative case)] worthy.</u> ⁵ He who overcomes will, like them, be dressed in white. <u>I will never blot out his name from the book of life</u>, but will <u>acknowledge his name before my Father and his angels</u>. ⁶ He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.

- ☐ They will be declared "worthy"!
- ☐ Their names will be written in the Lamb's Book of Life!
- ☐ They will be "presented" to the Father!
