STUDY VERSE SECTION - Isaiah 6:1-8, NIV84 -¹ *In the year that King Uzziah* [a popular King of Israel who reigned 52 years, great military leader, fine builder, valued “the arts:” as long as he sought the Lord, the people prospered. At the height of his prosperity, he transgressed and everything fell apart] *died, I saw the Lord seated on a throne, high and exalted, and the train of his robe filled the temple.* ² *Above him were seraphs* [angelic beings, mentioned only in this passage, the Hebrew root, *srp* means “to burn;” *seraph* is singular and *seraphim* is plural—which is used here; biblical archeologist found stone orthostats (→) showing six-winged angels that had the role of “carrying out orders”] *each with six wings: With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they were flying.* ³ *And they were calling* [lit., *proclaiming*] *to one another: “Holy, holy, holy* [repeated for emphasis is the Heb קדוֹשׁ (Ka-DŌSH) the strongest word for holiness] *is the LORD Almighty* [this word denotes *rank*—the highest rank]; *the whole earth is full of his glory.”* ⁴ *At the sound of their voices the doorposts and thresholds shook and the temple was filled with smoke.* ⁵ *“Woe to me!” I cried. “I am ruined! For I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips, and my eyes have seen the King, the LORD* [Heb. יהוה (Yahweh) the highest name for God] *Almighty.”* ⁶ *Then one of the seraphs flew to me with a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with tongs from the altar.* ⁷ *With it he touched my mouth and said, “See, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away and your sin atoned for.”* ⁸ *Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, “Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?” And I said, “Here am I. Send me!”* [Heb. שלֵּחַ (sha-la) the first person imperative of “send”]



What changed in Isaiah's life was...

1. His fresh vision of _____.

Isaiah 6:1-4, NLT -¹ *It was in the year King Uzziah died that I saw the Lord.* He was sitting on a lofty throne, and the train of his robe filled the Temple. ² *Attending him were mighty seraphim, each having six wings. With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they flew.* ³ *They were calling out to each other, “Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of Heaven’s Armies! The whole earth is filled with his glory!”* ⁴ *Their voices shook the Temple to its foundations, and the entire building was filled with smoke.*

2. His fresh vision of _____.

Isaiah 6:5, GNB -⁵ *I said, “There is no hope for me! I am doomed because every word that passes my lips is sinful, and I live among a people whose every word is sinful. And yet, with my own eyes, I have seen the King, the LORD Almighty!”*

3. His fresh vision of _____.

Isaiah 6:6-7, TLB -⁶ *Then one of the mighty angels flew over to the altar and with a pair of tongs picked out a burning coal.* ⁷ *He touched my lips with it and said, “Now you are pronounced ‘not guilty’ because this coal has touched your lips. Your sins are all forgiven.”*

4. His fresh vision of _____.

Isaiah 6:8, NASB95 -⁸ *Then I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, “Whom shall I send, and who will go for Us?” Then I said, “Here am I. Send me!”*
