### Can these bones live?

### A. How did the vision come about?

**Ezekiel 37:1, HCSB** -<sup>1</sup> <u>The hand of the LORD was on me</u>, and He brought me out by His Spirit and set me down in the middle of the valley; it was full of bones.

### B. What was the vision?

**Ezekiel 37:2, HCSB** -<sup>2</sup> <u>He led me all around [the dry bones]</u>. There were a great many of them on the surface of the valley, and they were very dry.

### C. What question was asked in the vision?

**Ezekiel 37:3, HCSB** -<sup>3</sup> Then He said to me, "Son of man, can these bones live?"

### D. What answer was given in the vision?

**Ezekiel 37:3, NASB95** -<sup>3</sup> He said to me, "Son of man, can these bones live?" And I answered, "<u>O Lord GOD, You know</u>."

### E. What remedy was presented in this vision?

**Ezekiel 37:4, NASB95** -<sup>4</sup> Again He said to me, "<u>Prophesy over these</u> <u>bones</u> and say to them, '<u>O dry bones, hear the word of the LORD</u>.'



# 1. God is very concerned about hurting and broken people.

**Ezekiel 37:4–6, HCSB** -<sup>4</sup> He said to me, "Prophesy concerning these bones and say to them: <u>Dry bones, hear the word of the LORD!</u> <sup>5</sup> <u>This is what the Lord GOD says to these bones: ...I will put breath in you so that you come to life</u>. Then you will know that I am Yahweh."

# 2. The depths of despair are where life' most important lessons are learned.

**Ezekiel 37:11–12, HCSB** -<sup>11</sup> Then He said to me, "Son of man, these bones are the whole house of Israel. Look how they say, '<u>Our bones</u> are dried up, and our hope has perished; we are cut off.'

## 3. The power of God can change even the most hopeless of lives and situation.

**Ezekiel 37:12–13, HCSB** - <sup>12</sup> Therefore, prophesy and say to them: This is what the Lord GOD says: <u>I am going to open your graves and</u> bring you up from them, My people, and lead you into the land of <u>Israel</u>. <sup>13</sup> You will know that I am Yahweh, My people, when I open your graves and bring you up from them.

# 4. Nothing happens among the people of God until the Wind blows.

**Ezekiel 37:9–10, TLB** -<sup>9</sup> <u>Then he told me to call to the wind and</u> <u>say</u>: "The Lord God says: Come from the four winds, O Spirit, and breathe upon these slain bodies, that they may live again." <sup>10</sup> So I spoke to the winds as he commanded me, <u>and the bodies began</u> breathing; they lived and stood up—a very great army.

### 5. God wants all people to know that He is Lord.

**Ezekiel 37:13, NIV84** - <sup>13</sup> Then you, my people, will know that <u>I am</u> <u>the LORD</u>.
